Since 2000, City Year Washington, DC has been planning and executing high-impact physical service projects for companies throughout the Greater Washington, DC area. These corporate service days engage our corporate partners in community service with the goals of:

- Creating **tangible change** in local communities by engaging the corporate sector;
- Spreading an **ethic of service** throughout the corporate community; and
- Providing **team-building opportunities** for corporate employees.

City Year Washington, DC strives to create service opportunities that are tailored to meet the needs of both our corporate partners and the communities we serve. Corporate service days are typically held on Fridays and Saturdays at a DC school, park, or recreation center, but can be designed to meet the specific needs of a company. - Identify the service location and design the scope of service for the event
- Provide all supplies and materials
- Manage the planning and logistics of the day, including:
 - Preparing the service site for the event
 - Running registration and service placement
 - Providing highly-trained team leaders to guide volunteers during the day of service
