City Year's dual mission is to advance academic outcomes for all students and develop the next generation of leaders through national service. Each day, our 110 City Year AmeriCorps members serve full-time in 15 Boston and Medford public schools, supporting over 8,500+ students – 89% of whom are youth of color – with individualized tutoring, mentorship, and encouragement to stay on track through high school, college, and career.

Our **Spring Into Service** event shines a spotlight on the impact of our AmeriCorps members while equipping students and teachers with the resources they need to finish the year with confidence. Volunteers will assemble resource kits and materials that directly support classrooms, while also engaging in opportunities to connect with colleagues and deepen their understanding of City Year's mission. Last year, together we created more than 1,000 supply kits, and in 2026, we're aiming even higher.
