

## Scholastic Showdown Rules

- We will have 4 rounds of competition throughout the evening.
- At the beginning of each round, teams will be made up of guests who secured their spots to play before the event and guests who will be randomly selected. We will call you to the zoom stage. Which means you will be promoted to a panelist.
- Team names have been pre-assigned and are named after schools that we serve in!
- Each round will have two teams of 3 people competing for a total of 6 players on the zoom stage.
- There will be 10 questions in each round.
- Each player will be able to answer at least 3 questions with one player answering 4.
- The questions will be pulled from 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade. The higher the grade level the more points the team earns for getting the question correct. But also the more difficult the question is.
  - Points will be earned as follows:
    - Question 1&2: 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Level= 1 point
    - Question 3&4: 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Level= 2 points
    - Question 5&6: 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Level= 3 points
    - Question 7&8: 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Level= 4 points
    - Question 9&10: 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Level= 5 points
- The game will start with 1 member from each team turning on their camera and facing off for the first question. We will randomly select the order that you play.
- When it's your turn please turn your camera on. If it is not your turn please turn your camera off.
- Players will use a piece of paper and marker or pen from home to write their answers. Please make sure it is large enough to read. And that you have enough paper or enough room on the paper for multiple questions.
- Players will to write down their answer
  - If you don't know the answer each player will get one "copy" where they can find a person from their team via chat to answer the question for them or the player can phone a friend or ask a roommate. The player will then have to use that answer. No googling allowed.
  - Once the time is up players will show their paper to the audience
  - I will then read the correct answer
  - Each team will get points if their player answers them correctly
- The team with the highest points out of all 4 rounds will go to the final round where the category will be the 10<sup>th</sup> grade level questions. The players from the team will compete against each other.
  - If there is a tie we will do a tie breaker round. Where 1 player will compete from each team in a rapid fire round. Whoever gets the most questions correct in 2 minutes their team will move on to the final round.
  - Players cannot "copy" in the final round
  - There will be 10 questions in this round. The player with the highest score first will win the grand prize of 80,000 AAdvantage Miles. Which in case you're wondering, this is the equivalent of TWO roundtrip flights, provided by our Official Airline Sponsor American Airlines!
