JOYS

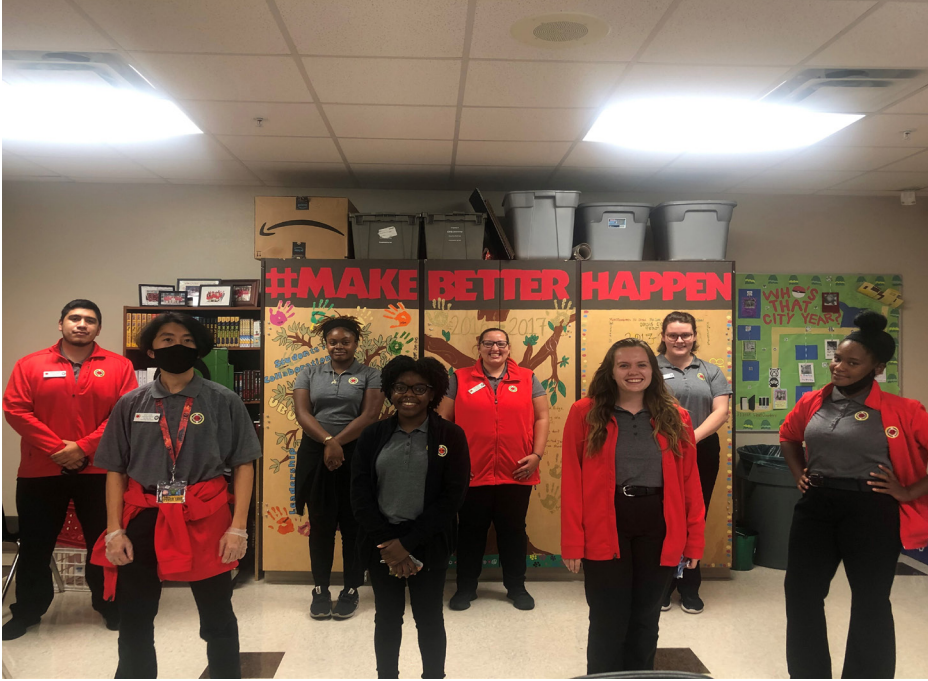
- Power mingling has been a huge success – our team loves greeting our students in the morning with fun music!
