# SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

A national study found that making gains in social-emotional skills is like gaining an entire year of growth in math or English for students. Spending more time with City Year AmeriCorps members was tied to academic gains, better attendance and stronger social-emotional skills for students.

### Answers:

RELATIONSHIP BUILDING

AmeriCorps members build developmental relationships with students, a foundation necessary for students to acquire critical skills and engage deeply with their learning.

GROWTH MINDSET

AmeriCorps members help students practice this skill. Someone who has a growth mindset embraces challenges and perseveres when they face obstacles.

GOAL SETTING

AmeriCorps members encourage their students to set goals including participating more in class, persevering through a challenging math assignment, or practicing self-awareness in the classroom.

BELONGING

City Year AmeriCorps members work with educators to help create a welcoming school environment where each student feels like they belong and is excited to engage and learn.



City Year AmeriCorps members develop powerful relationships with students and help create an environment where students can build on their strengths, take risks in their learning and feel connected to their school community.
