Dr. Victor Amaya leads Data You Can Use as President & Executive Director, aiming to democratize data for community well-being. With a background as an educator and leader, he previously held key positions at City Year Milwaukee. Born in Mexico, he moved to Milwaukee at twelve, graduated from Riverside University High School, and earned a Bachelor's in Sociology and Spanish from UW-Parkside. He holds a Master's and Doctorate in Leadership, along with various educational licenses.

Dr. Amaya actively contributes to his community, serving as Founding Director of Techqueria-Milwaukee and on the executive boards of the National Neighborhood Indicators Partnership, Southside Organizing Center, and Your Move MKE. He also founded Limitless Mindset, LLC, a consultancy firm. His mission centers on creating opportunities and dismantling barriers to equity.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP FOR ALL



Meralis T. Hood is the CEO of Entrepreneurship for All (EforAll), leading the organization's efforts to support under-represented entrepreneurs nationwide. Notably, she launched EforAll's first online Business Accelerator program in 2024, expanding access to resources in Arizona, California, and Texas. With a strong background in education and non-profit leadership, Hood aims to empower communities through accessible resources and build autonomy.

Prior to EforAll, Hood served as a market president at City Year, Inc., overseeing operations across 29 sites and driving strategic partnerships and previously served as Executive Director of City Year Milwaukee. She also held various roles in Milwaukee Public Schools, including assistant principal at Bay View High School and a bilingual teacher. Hood is passionate about strengthening communities and supporting mental health efforts, as evidenced by her involvement with the Hillsborough Organization for Progress and Equity. She holds degrees from Marquette University, UW-Milwaukee, and National Louis University.

HONORARY CHAIR





David Crowley made history in May 2020 as the youngest and first Black Milwaukee County Executive, a role he secured a second term in with 85% of the vote in 2024. A lifelong Milwaukee resident, Crowley's leadership is driven by a deep understanding of the city's disparities. His administration focuses on building bridges, fostering prosperity, and creating a safer, healthier Milwaukee County.

Since taking office, Crowley implemented a county-wide strategic plan centered on racial equity, aiming to make Milwaukee the healthiest county in Wisconsin. He diversified county positions, streamlined services, and secured crucial revenue through Wisconsin Act 12, reforming the state's local revenue-sharing structure. Crowley is also focused on expanding mental health services, addressing the opioid epidemic, increasing affordable housing, and investing in public transit and economic development. He is actively involved in community organizations, including the ACLU and NAACP, and serves as Chair of the NACo Large Urban Counties Caucus. Crowley, who grew up in Milwaukee's 53206 neighborhood, holds a bachelor's degree from UW-Milwaukee and lives with his wife and three daughters.
