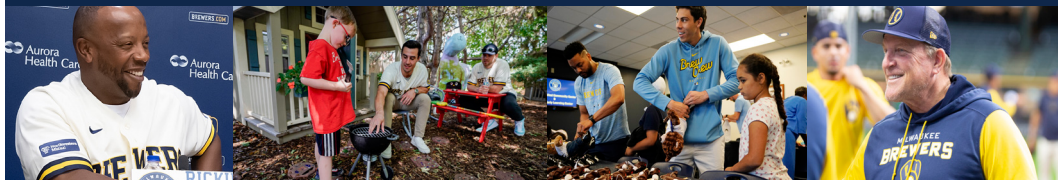

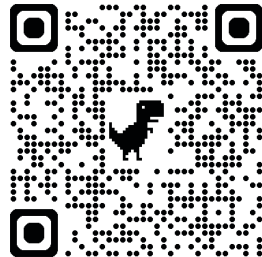

MILWAUKEE TEACHING FELLOWSHIP SPOTLIGHT

City Year's Teaching Fellowships are multi-year teacher preparation pathways, modeled after medical residency training. Our approach allows currently serving AmeriCorps members and City Year alumni to develop critical skills and mindsets that foster learning and growth for all students, especially those we serve.

Uniquely designed for AmeriCorps members and alumni, City Year's Teaching Fellowships strive to remove barriers to entering the teaching field through partnerships with institutions of higher education, and make the process more streamlined and more affordable.

In addition to the Segal Education Award AmeriCorps members receive at the completion of their service, Teaching Fellows can earn a graduate degree, teaching license, and living stipend while paying considerably less for their teacher preparation program.

City Year Milwaukee is in our founding year of the Teaching Fellowship program. We have partnered with teachers from Milwaukee Public Schools who have stepped up as Mentor Teachers to train Teaching Fellows alongside our partner institute of higher education – Arizona State University. The Mentor Teachers are teachers within our partner schools who open their classroom for a full school year to co-teach with, and support City Year Milwaukee Teaching Fellows as they earn a master's degree and teaching certification.

We are so proud of our Founding Teaching Fellows, **Emily VanHandel** and **Thomas Connor**. Emily has served and taught in two Sophomore Algebra 1 classes and three Junior Algebra 2 classes this year. Thomas has served and taught in four Freshman Citizenship classes and one Upper-Level Elective Holocaust class.

Both hope to receive full-time teaching positions in Milwaukee Public Schools for the 2024-2025 school year.
